- Initiated and spearheaded the complete redesign and rewrite of Ace Ticket's flagship ecommerce site from their current legacy Laravel 4.2 PHP codebase to a fully responsive server-side rendered React web application using Next.js and Redux.
- Gathered requirements from business stakeholders including VPs, EVPs and company ownership, and built two comprehensive sets of interactive UI prototypes for desktop and mobile designs using Axure RP, which I presented to stakeholders.
- Researched and selected the new front-end stack, and built working client-side and server-side rendering proof-of-concept apps emulating Ace Ticket's current Event page functionality which were presented to business stakeholders.
- I began implementing the approved Axure RP designs in a greenfield Next.js-based app using React and Redux principles.
- Conceived, designed, and implemented a total UX redesign of the checkout process for Ace Ticket's current ecommerce site which resulted in a ~15% decrease in checkout abandonment since going live in Spring of 2019.
- Identified and implemented high-profile new features alongside UX improvements and bugfixes for Ace Ticket's current ecommerce site which annually generates tens of millions in revenue. Examples include:
 - A total redesign of Ace Ticket's "Ticket Filter" toolbar for event pages to improve discoverability and facilitate repeated use.
 - A new "Service Fee Comparison" feature for Event pages which highlighted Ace Ticket's industry-low service fees against our chief competitors including Stubhub & SeatGeek. This feature was frequently singled out for praise from customers in Trustpilot reviews.
 - Complete audit and improvement of legacy code resulting in ~3 seconds decrease in average page load time across the site.
- Conducted A/B testing for prospective new site features using PhpAb, Google Tag Manager & Google Analytics.
- Overhauled Ace Ticket's Google Tag Manager implementation to both resolve issues stemming from missing and bad analytics data and improve user behavior metrics reported to Google Analytics.
- Built robust analytic dashboards in Google Data Studio to report on site usage and ecommerce conversion trends not provided directly by Google Analytics
- Designed the branding and designed & implemented the UI for a new portal for Ace Ticket's "Ace Elite" corporate client program.
